

Taxes Due 4/18/2023

Federal Income Taxes are due on April 18th. The IRS will begin processing 2022 returns 1/24/2023.

The Child Credit amounts are back to 2020 levels. \$2,000 per child under 17.

Educator Expense Deduction increased to \$300.

Kansas now also has a Teacher's Deduction for Classroom supplies.

Mileage rates have increased for Business & Medical.

If you have health insurance "through the Marketplace" you will receive form 1095A, to reconcile on your tax return.

Big tax credits for Energy related Home improvements - starting in 2023.

You can get your refund in check, direct deposit, or in I-Bonds.

Kansas and Missouri now have a deduction for individuals who set up and contribute to a "First Time Homebuyers Savings Account".

Kansas has a Disabled Access Credit for costs of making a home accessible to individuals with disabilities.

Missouri now has a deduction for contributing to a Long Term Care Dignity Account.
